**INSTRUCTORS:** Art Camp is led by Maizy Goerlitz, Jailee Bishop and Trinity Pine, three seniors enrolled at West Sound Academy. Parents are informed that this is a student-led camp with WSA staff on campus during camp hours but not directly involved in the instruction.

### CAMP DESCRIPTION:

Art camp is a four day exploratory visual art class where students will explore painting, collage, drawing and free time using materials to create visual art pieces. Students will be given instruction, opening activities, and time to explore their own interests and techniques. Students will be provided recess breaks and snacks.

**PAYMENT** - Cash, check, Visa and MasterCard accepted on site. WSA students are billed through their school account. Non-WSA Students must be pre-paid by the start of the first session.

**WITHDRAWAL & REFUND** – There is no pro-ration or refund if a student fails to attend a class for any reason including illness. No refunds will be provided for withdrawal after August 1, 2018.

POLICIES - WSA reserves the right to refuse enrollment to participants with a history of unacceptable behavior or to expel a student from a class without refund in which he or she is already enrolled for unacceptable behavior.
